The ideal candidate will initiate and foster a connection between the church and the local community and provide vision and leadership for church programs currently in place.

Responsibilities

- Identify community needs
- Create, develop and implement programs designed to promote the church to the people of the surrounding community, with the goal of encouraging them to become active members of the church
- Provide leadership and vision for current church programs such as Sunday School, summer programs and Youth Group
- Recruit, train and organize volunteers to assist in the implementation and maintenance of these programs
- Assist in maintaining a social media presence

Education and Experience

- This position requires a Bachelors Degree in Theology or a related field and/or equivalent training and experience
- He or She should possess a documented ability to work effectively with youth, diverse individuals and teams of volunteers
- Excellent written, verbal and computer skills are essential
- Fluency in Spanish, experience with conflict management and contemporary music a plus
